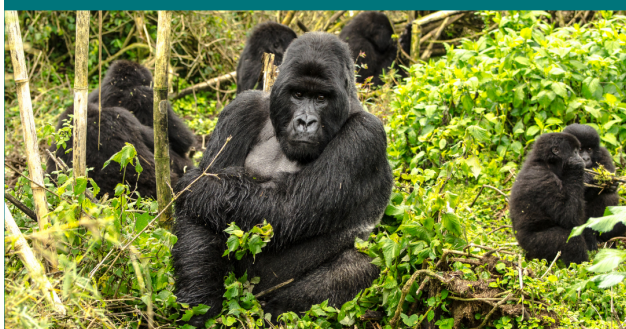

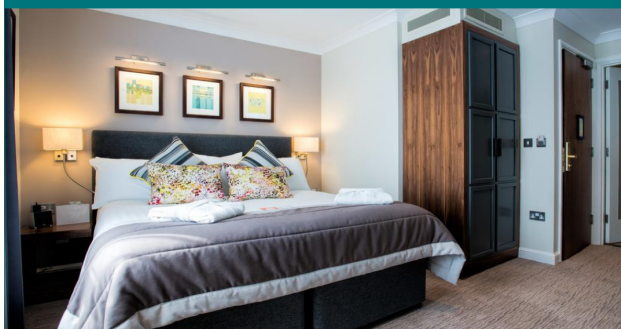

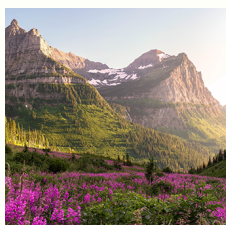
Chile from December to February
